### Parent/Teacher/Student Interviews

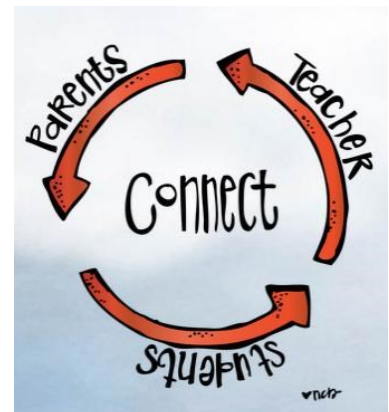

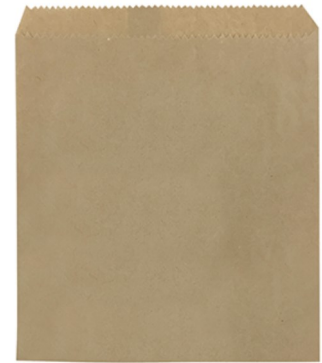


## Lunch Orders
