## Whole School Pool Fun Day

On Thursday, 5 December 2024, we are holding a Fun Day at the Red Cliffs Swimming Pool.

The day will consist of water-based activities. Students will represent their sports house and play for fun. We ask students to dress up in their house colours. Red (Bryne), green (Ryan), blue (Taylor) and yellow (McLennon).

#### Time:

Students will leave school from 11:30 am and return to school by 3 pm.

### **Transportation:** Bus
