Teachers have finalised end of year reports for 2024. The reports will be live on COMPASS this afternoon.

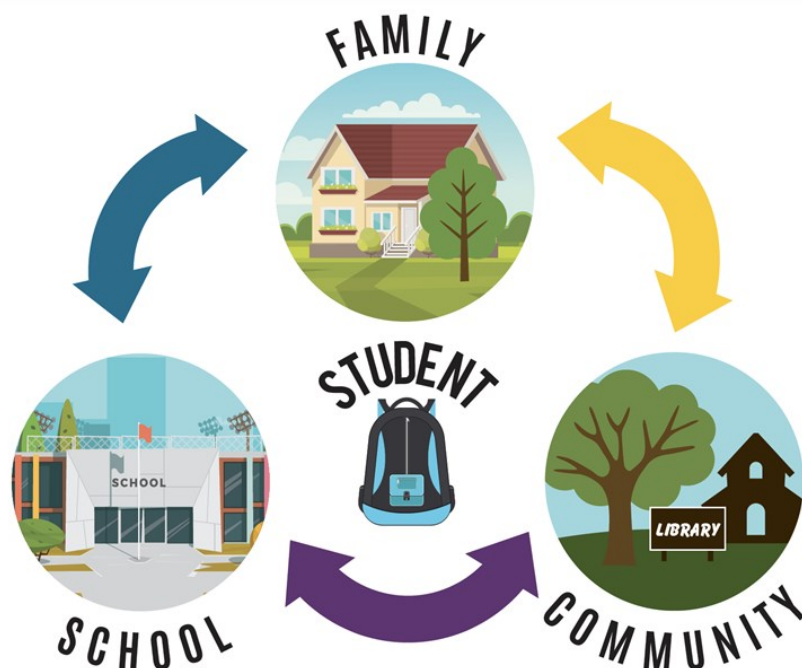
You can download the reports from COMPASS and print them out or send them to a relative via email. Hard copies have not been sent home.
